SUBJECTS AVAILABLE FOR ERASMUS+ STUDENTS

This document serves as guide to potential subjects which will be available during 2026/2027 academic year. Please note that **final course catalogue and timetables will be available in mid-to-late August 2026.**

Erasmus exchange students may change their LA / OLA in the *During the Mobility* within:

- first 3 weeks of September for Autumn semester;
- first 3 weeks of February for Spring semester.

During the first two-week Erasmus exchange period, students will be able to attend various lectures, including those not initially included in their Learning Agreement, in order to select courses that best fit their academic needs and timetable.

Students may select subjects from different study years (1–3) and are not restricted to courses corresponding to their year of study at the home institution, unless explicitly required by the home institution.

By the 3rd week of studies students must submit all the changes (if any) in LA and create Study Plan (will be available in September). **No changes will accepted after 3 week period ends.**
